Carbon Monoxide (CO)



Carbon Monoxide (CO) is a highly poisonous gas which can be produced by carbon-fuel-burning equipment, such as gas stoves, lamps and fires



You are at risk if your appliance is:

- Not checked regularly or maintained
- Not properly installed
- Not working properly
- Not regularly checked or maintained
- Not provided with enough fresh air (ventilation)
- Not used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions
- Used without a tested, working CO alarm

DON'T cook in small, poorly ventilated spaces or in areas where people sleep

DO use a CO alarm as an added precaution
