Travel Documents

You will NEED:

- **Passport**
 - Must be valid: expiry date after 5 November 2024
 - Passport details must be updated on EventsAir by 1 April
 - RENEW NOW!

- **GHIC**
 - UK Global Health Insurance Card or European Health Insurance Card
 - Must be in date for the whole event
 - Gives you free access to state-provided healthcare
 - Make sure you have one by 1 April
 - Order for free from gov.uk
