Norwegian Phrase of the Roundup

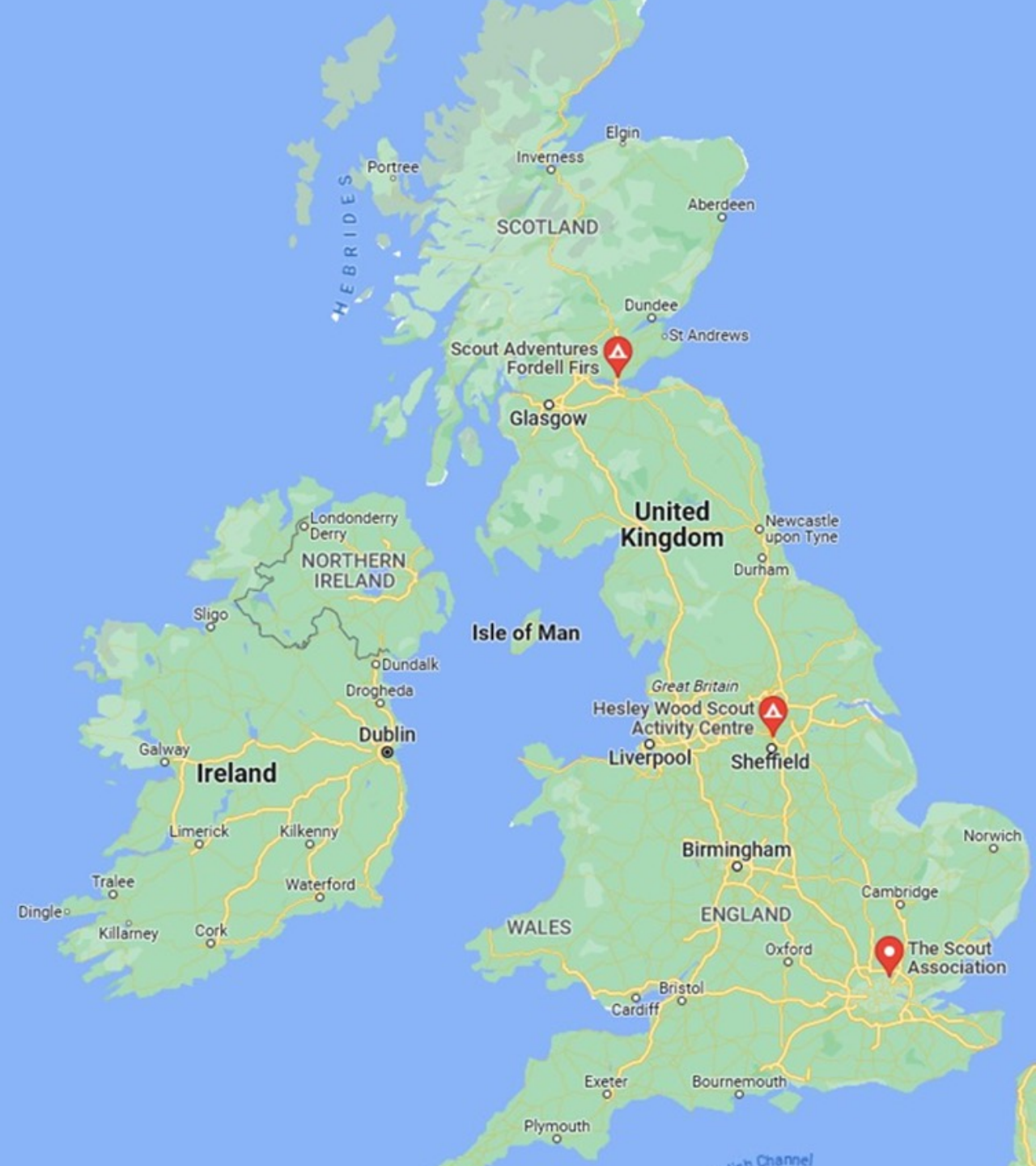
“Jeg heter Shaun”

Roverway on Tour

- An opportunity for patrols to spend time together, meet CMT and plan your journey
- We have allocated each patrol and IST member to your nearest location:
 - **Hesley Wood** near Sheffield
 - **Fordell Firs** near Edinburgh
 - **Gilwell Park** in North East London
- We will contact you in the next three weeks to confirm your Roverway on Tour location and date
- You may want to book camping or accommodation on-site. To do this you'll need to meet Nights Away requirements and make your own arrangements with the site.



Payment of fees



- **Participants in a patrol:** your County/Nation now has details of fees and will be in contact with you directly to arrange a series of payments over the next year
- **IST members:** we will contact you directly about payments after registration (more on the next slide)

- Paths mark the start of your in-country journey, joining other patrols from across Europe for the first five days
- Your patrol chooses its path: there will be a path for everyone, whatever your interests
- Our Norway hosts will open paths for registration in January
- We will provide guidance to support you in registering your chosen path
