Add-on Packages

- As part of the contingent experience, we are offering three add-on packages. These are optional and can be added on as you choose (i.e. you could pick one, two or all three).
- These are based the slides that were presented at our Moot Monday on 03/05/2021 to give an overview of the different add-on packages.
- The slides have been changed since Moot Monday to take on board feedback we received.
- You will receive an email in the next few weeks which will give exact details and prices to allow you to make a decision on which packages you would like to select.
- At that point you will then be able to make payment two via our online booking system, which will comprise of 20% of your base fee, plus a £50 deposit for any add-on packages you decide to select.

- Guideline price **£185** per person

- **Belfast Pre-Event Experience**

- Available to participants (IST already on site)
- Guideline price **£225** per person

- **Dublin Post-Event Experience**

- Available to participants (IST on site for organisers party)
- Guideline price **£90** per person

If you attend the Pre-Event & Post-Event

If you attend the Pre-Event only

- ⇒ Regional Hub to Belfast via Bus and Ferry
- ↓ Belfast to Dublin via Bus for the Opening Ceremony
- ⇐ Dublin to Regional Airport via plane

If you attend the Post-Event only

- ⇒ Regional Airport to Dublin via plane
- ⇐ Dublin to Regional Hub via bus and ferry

If you attend the Moot only

- ⇒ Regional Airport to Dublin via plane
- ⇐ Dublin to Regional Airport via plane

- ⇒ Regional Airport to Dublin via plane
- ⇐ Dublin to Regional Airport via plane

There are no additional tours for IST. However, we are looking into a potential for a one-way travel package to get you to the Moot only. This means that you would be able to extend your stay and explore Ireland after the Moot, arranging your own travel home.



Moot Participant Contingent Travel

As you may know, we're planning to be the most sustainable UK Contingent to date! After looking into different travel options, the most sustainable option is to travel via the ferry across the Irish Sea.

This will include a coach from regional hubs across the UK and a ferry to Ireland. The ferry will be packed full of activities and challenges to keep you entertained and busy while on board. We hope as many people as possible will take this option to reduce our carbon footprint.

In order for the coach journeys to be sustainable we have to ensure that the coaches are full, so we may shuffle people around before boarding the ferry.

- If you attend both the Pre- and Post-Events, you'll travel to and from Ireland via bus and ferry.
- If you only attend the Pre-Event, you'll travel to the Moot via bus and ferry, but fly back.
- If you only attend the Post-Event, you'll fly out and return via bus and ferry.
- If you only attend the Moot, you'll fly both ways.

Participant – Travel to Dublin 18th July

(NO PRE-EVENT)

If you don't wish to attend the Pre-Event, but select Contingent Travel, we will get you to Dublin on Monday morning. As the ferry journeys arrive in the evening, this will not be an option. Therefore, we will fly you into Dublin Airport.

IST – Contingent Travel

Outward Travel - Saturday 16th July

- Travel to Dublin will be by flights from a Regional Airport.
- This is due to the time of the opening ceremony in Dublin for IST on the Saturday which will be in the early evening and also to make sure you arrive at a sensible time to pitch your tent and get settled.

Return Travel - Saturday 30th July

- All IST are to depart Dublin in the afternoon after the Thank You Brunch.
- As part of the Travel Add-on we will fly you home from Dublin to a Regional Airport.
- If you are not booking Contingent Travel, the thank you brunch will be finished from approx. 14:30.
- There are no additional tours for IST. However, we are looking into a potential for a one-way travel package to get you to the Moot only. This means that you would be able to extend your stay and explore Ireland after the Moot, arranging your own travel home.

Independent Travel

- This isn't the hard sell to take the Contingent travel add on. It's to help you decide what works best for you.
- We want to give a realistic idea of travel costs so that you can budget appropriately
- Prices quoted are based on travelling on similar days this July and are the lowest price found
- Consider using the most sustainable travel method available.





Arrival and Departure Dates

• Participants

- Arrive in Dublin on Monday 18th July 2022 in time to register and then attend an opening ceremony at 11am.
- Depart anytime on Friday 29th July 2022
- Pre-Event arrive in Belfast afternoon Sat 16th July
- Post-Event depart Dublin anytime Sat 30th July

• IST

- Arrive in Dublin anytime on Saturday 16th July 2022
- Depart on Saturday 30th July 2022
- Don't forget brunch! (running till approx. 4pm)

Flights

- Advertised prices by airlines do not include luggage
- Airlines sell seats on a tiered price structure
- Flights in the summer are generally more expensive than other times of the year
- Travel agents can reserve seats on flights before they are released to the general public
- There could be a lot of demand for flights on arrival and departure days

- Coach and Sail options are available from Scotland and other major cities.

- Secure parking for 2 weeks at Dublin airport around £50/60
- Cost of fuel
- Additional insurance costs for taking car abroad or adding additional drivers
