

# Tools information



## Trowel

- Digs over small flower beds
- Digs small holes for plants and bulbs



## Fork

- Lifts root crops (such as potatoes)
- Turns over soil
- Digs over larger flower or vegetable beds
- Gets large lumps out of the soil



## Spade

- Digs big holes
- Moves soil from one place to another



## Secateurs

- Cuts flowers
- Prunes plants and bushes



### Watering can

- Waters plants
- If someone puts a 'rose' on the spout, it turns the water into droplets like rain



### Hoe

- Removes weeds
- Digs drills for planting seeds
- Heaps soil into piles (around potato plants)
- Smooths soil ready for seeds



### Edging tool

- Cuts neat edges between lawns and beds



### Loppers, pruners, or shears

- Chop branches
- Prune bushes and trees
- Cut grass in awkward corners



### Rake

- Collects leaves
- Collects grass after cutting it
- Collects weeds



### Gloves

- Keep people's hands clean when gardening
- Stop people's hands getting scratched



### Wellington boots

- Keep people's feet warm and dry when gardening
- Keep people's feet out of the mud



### Bulb planter

- Digs holes for bulbs



### Wheelbarrow

- Easily moves heavy tools and soil
- Carries compost around the garden
