Statement	Answer	Reason
You're visiting the Eiffel Tower in France when you see a motorbike crash.	112	You're not in the UK. Dialling 112 from a mobile phone will connect you to the emergency services for the country you are in.
Your friend has fainted and won't get up.	999	They might need to be taken to hospital. Call 999 and ask for an ambulance.
There was a crime in your local area and you think you have information that might help the police.	101	Call 101 to give police information that might help them solve a crime.
Your neighbour isn't feeling well and would like some advice on what to do.	111	They can call 111 to get medical advice. The operator can help them decide what to do next.
You are playing on the beach and see a sailor has fallen into the water.	999	999 is the emergency number for the coastguard and other rescue services.
You are hiking in Spain when you spot a bush fire.	112	You are not in the UK. Dialling 112 from a mobile phone will connect you to the emergency services for the country you are in.
Someone tells you they've had a really bad headache all day and are worried.	111	Call 111 to ask for medical advice.
You walk past a house and see a lot of thick smoke coming out the windows.	999	This might be a fire. Call 999 and ask for the fire services.
Your friend's bike has been stolen. No one is around but their bike is not where they locked it.	101	It's not an emergency as the crime is not currently taking place. Call 101 to report a crime that has already taken place.
You see a car being broken into.	999	The crime is currently taking place. Go to a safe place and call 999 for the police.
You arrive home and the lights won't switch on. You try another room and no lights are working.	105	This may be a power cut. Look outside and see if the street lights are on. If they are, it might just be your house that has no electricity. Call 105 to report it.
The TV and lights suddenly cut out. You look outside and the street lights are also off.	105	This is a power cut. It might be temporary but calling 105 means you can report it.
