What can you spot?

You can write or draw the answers, or take pictures if you're allowed.



The building

How old is the building? There might be a date on the building, or it may just look old or new.	
Did it used to be something else? The building may have been built to be this place or worship, or maybe it used to be something else, such as a school or a house.	
Is there any furniture? Look for places to sit. Is there special seating for certain people, for example, choirs or worship leaders?	
Are there any special features? Look for doors, windows, carvings, pillars, altars, or places to keep the holy book(s).	

The people who worship there

Do people stand, sit, or kneel? The furniture may help you figure it out.	
Do people wear any special clothes? Look at someone who's worshipping, or ask someone who works there.	
When do people visit? Do they visit on one day of the week or can they come in whenever they like?	
How do worshippers prepare? Do they take off their shoes? Do they wash? Do they make any signs?

The people who lead the worship

Where do the people who lead the worship stand? Is there a special chair or place to stand?	
Is there a special place to read or speak? Is there a microphone?	
Do they wear special clothes? There may even be someone who can show you their special clothes.	
How many people lead the worship? Ask someone if there's one main leader or if several people help to lead.	
Decoration and art	

Is there any art or decoration? Look for paintings, patterns, and other	
art such as embroidery or sculpture.	
Is the ceiling decorated? Look at the shape of the ceiling too.	
Can you see any special books or scriptures?	
Remember not to touch. Just look at any books, any decoration, and the places they're kept.	
Is the space light or dark? Look at windows and lights. Are some areas lighter or darker than others?
