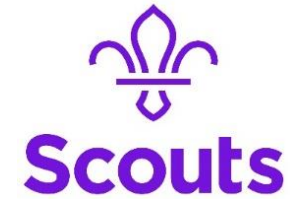
In about six weeks, we'll have a beautiful display that celebrates everyone's achievements and shows the range of hobbies and skills everyone has.
