# **HINTS & ANSWERS**

CLUE 1: What word is immediately after 'boojum tree' in a dictionary? It's something that you read, and could be fiction or non-fiction. Add an 's' onto the end to make this singular noun plural.

**ANSWER: BOOKS** 

CLUE 2: What three letter word is in between 'arduous' and 'area' in a dictionary? This word is the present plural of 'be'.

**ANSWER: ARE** 

CLUE 3: What's the first letter of the alphabet, and the first word listed in a dictionary?

**ANSWER: A** 

CLUE 4: Look up 'amazingly', 'singularly' and 'specially' in a thesaurus, and find the synonym for each of these that begins with 'U' and ends in 'Y'.

**ANSWER: UNIQUELY** 

CLUE 5: Look up 'moveable' and 'easily carried' in a thesaurus, and find the synonym for each of these that begins with 'P' and ends in 'E'.

**ANSWER: PORTABLE** 

CLUE 6: Look up 'spell', 'alchemy', 'sorcery', and 'wizardry' in a thesaurus, and find the synonym for each of these that begins with 'M' and ends in 'C'.
