Instructions

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Ask your section if they can think of any examples where outcomes have been better because people worked collaboratively. These could be wellknown events, things they've done as a group, or even fictional stories, like the way the Avengers work together for the greater good. Some famous realworld examples include the team that discovered the structure of DNA, or the team at the European Space Agency, who worked with Tim Peake to send him to the International Space Station.

> 2 Encourage everyone to share a talent or skill that they have with the rest of the team.

As a group, decide on a fundraising event and discuss how everyone's talents could be used. For example, one young person may have strong visual skills that could mean they would be good at videography, so they could make a video for your GoFundMe page. Another person might be good at public speaking and enjoy welcoming people to the event. Perhaps someone's a great cook or baker and can provide snacks. Any artists in the group might want to design posters to advertise the event.

Now that you know what fundraising event you're organising, a leader should use GoFundMe to set up on online fundraising campaign. For tips
