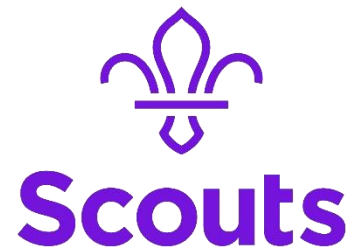


Tartan colour picker

Learn about the significance of different colours to help you choose which wools to weave.



Colours are connected to many things, and it's important to understand that they mean different things in different cultures for different people. Understanding colour can be hard and the meanings of some colours can be complete opposites.

Below we'll look at some colours and the meanings you could assign to them. Use as little or as many as you'd like to make your tartan.

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| <p>Black</p> <p>You like arts and crafts, and care for other people's feelings.</p> | <p>White</p> <p>You're very good tidying up after activities.</p> |
| <p>Red</p> <p>You're brave and don't give up when things are tough; you always try to do your best.</p> | <p>Blue</p> <p>You're thoughtful, and always happy to help your friends and family.</p> |
| <p>Green</p> <p>You like doing outdoor activities and enjoy nature.</p> | <p>Yellow</p> <p>You enjoy learning and sharing what you've learnt with others.</p> |
| <p>Brown</p> <p>You're a good friend and try your hardest to be reliable.</p> | |
