Habitat helpers

Give your project a name!

List everything you can think of to make your project happen!

- Create the community garden where people will tend to it
- Gather a team of volunteers to create the garden and look after it over time
- Spread the word: local press
- Add different habitats and homes to the garden for bugs, birds and other wildlife.

Where:
Find a place for our garden - is there anything near where our group meets? A roundabout, an abandoned plot, an unused part of our local park... or a roof?

What will we add? What seeds? What habitats?
Bug hotels, bird boxes, a hedgehog hogitat?

Who can help?
Ask local businesses about land, local council, can garden centres donate seeds?

Before we begin:
Let's carry out a survey on this patch to see what wildlife and plants might be there already.

OUR AIM:
To increase nature, increase biodiversity and encourage wildlife to our local area

WE'LL KNOW THE PROJECT WORKED IF:
We have planted a wildflower garden and created at least 5 homes for wildlife.

FIRST STEP: PREPARE
Plan what and where the garden will be.

Community
Ask mums and dads and local business people with right skills to help: maybe some will volunteer?

SECOND STEP: LEARN
How do we prepare land, plant seeds, create bug hotels?

Leaders
Research: books, Internet - the WWF website

THIRD STEP: MAKE IT HAPPEN
Think about timings and who will be responsible to make it all happen!

Family and friends
What skills are already in the group?
