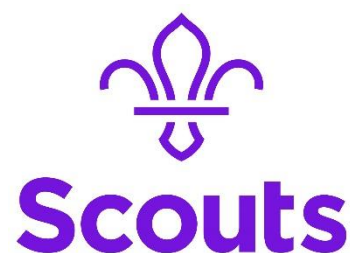


# Guess the numbers

Print and cut out the answer options below and share them amongst your young people. Read out the statement and ask them to hold up their answer if they think it's the right one.



## Statements to read out:

- The number of children around the world who have been forced to leave their homes because of conflict (30 million).
- Two-thirds of all the refugees in the world come from these five countries (Syria, Afghanistan, South Sudan, Myanmar and Somalia).
- The number of people who have to leave their homes every day because of conflict and persecution (37,000).
- These five countries are hosting the largest numbers of refugees (Germany, Sudan, Uganda, Pakistan, Turkey).
- These countries have some of the largest groups of internally displaced people – that's people who have been forced to flee their homes but haven't left their countries (Colombia, Syria, Democratic Republic of the Congo and Somalia – watch out, Syria and Somalia feature twice!).
- The number of children around the world who are either missing school or having their education disrupted because of crises (75 million).
- The percentage of children around the world who attend secondary school (84%) and the percentage of refugees who do (22%).
