Paths

What is a path?

- A path is the first half of Roverway
- It'll be from the 22nd – 27th July
- They will be patrol based
- Approximately 5-6 patrols on each pathway
- Each path will be a mix of countries
- Approximately 100 paths in total

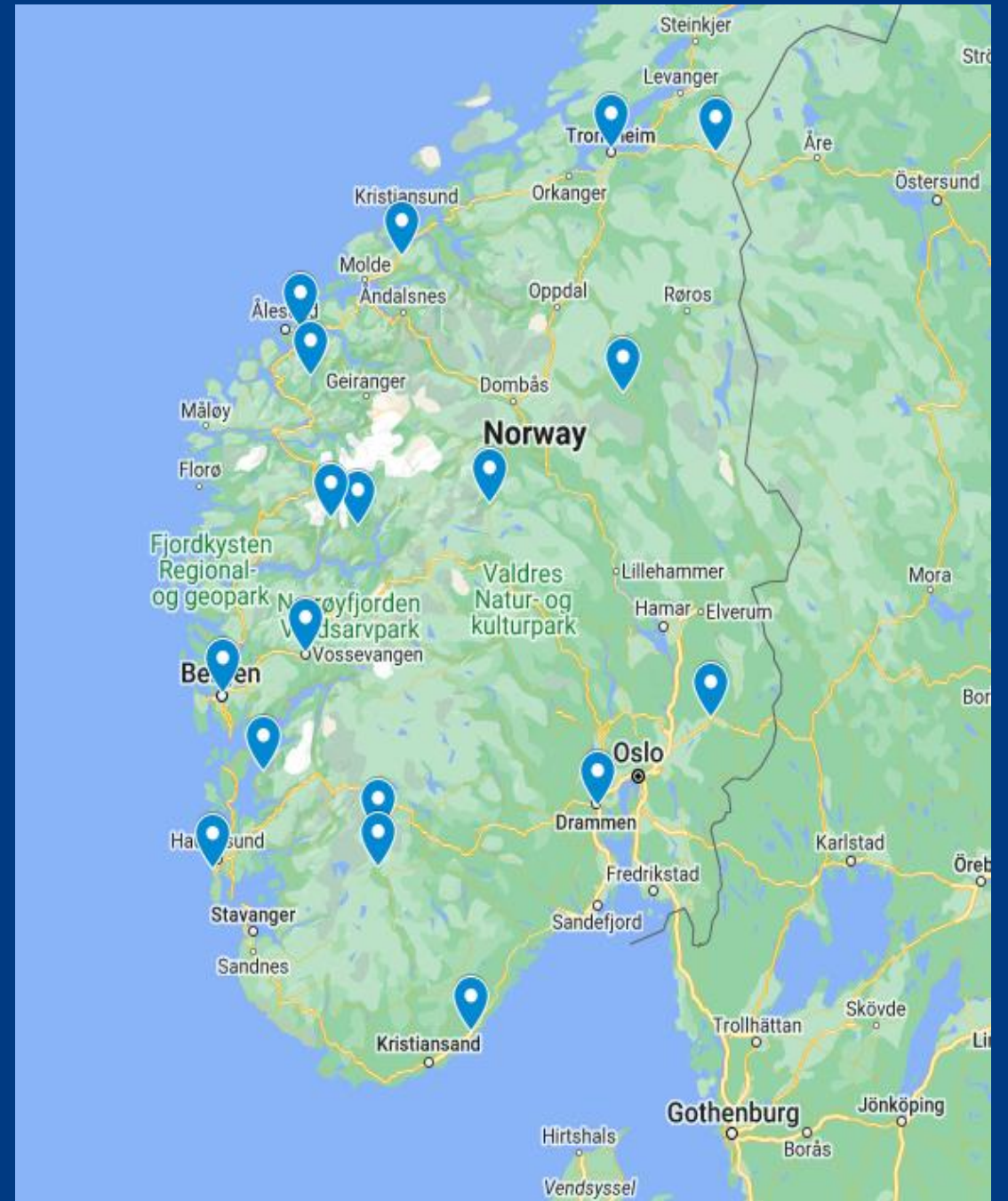


Where are they?

- They will be spread among Norway, Sweden & Denmark
- We don't know where every path will be yet.
- They have said they won't go further north than the line on the map
- Norway has said there will be a mix of different locations

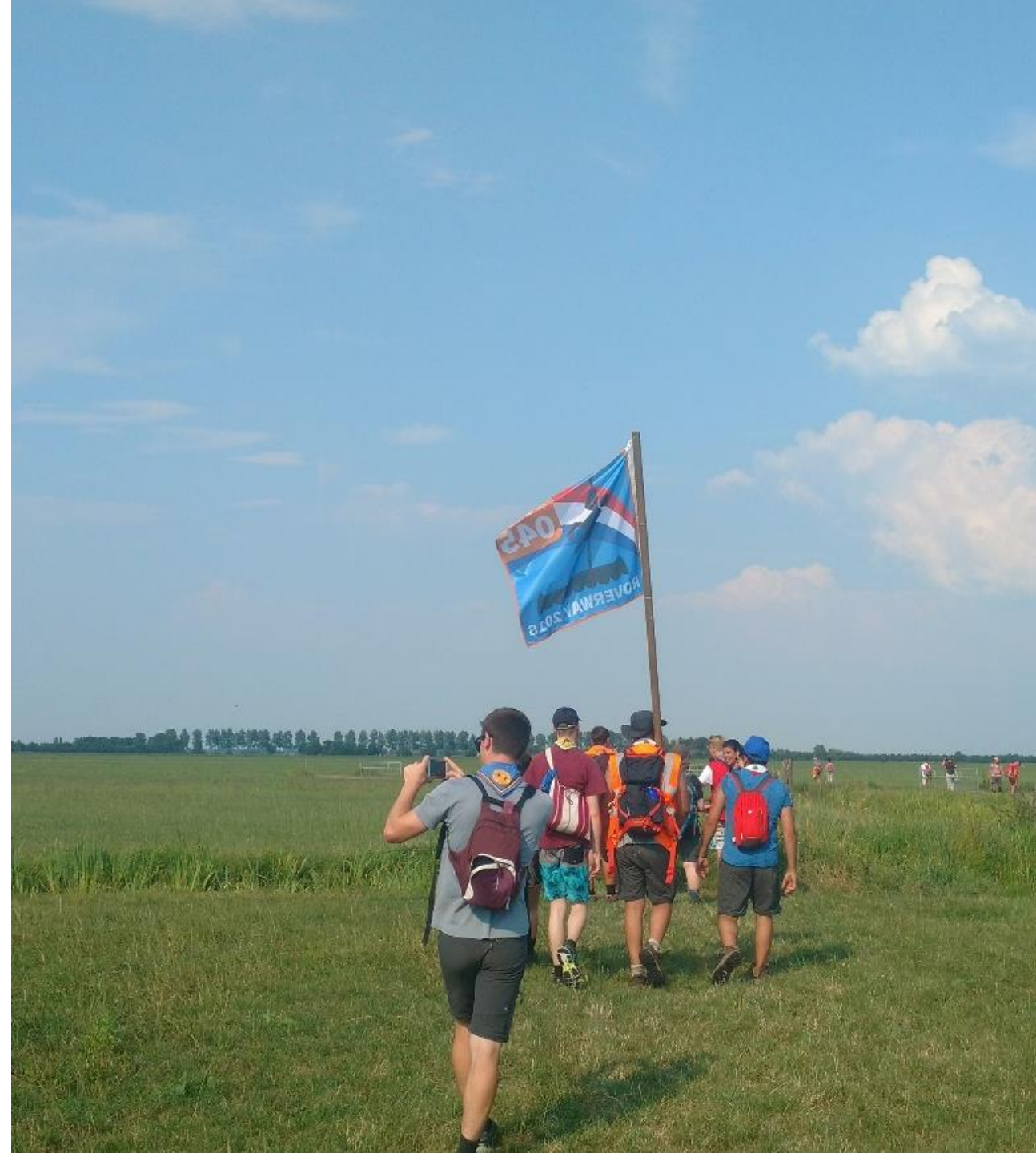
Activity categories:

How will you select?

- **Via an EventsAir form soon**
 - Static /dynamic - priority (Static, Dynamic)
 - Electricity access - Checkbox
 - Water access - Checkbox
 - Physical activity level - priority (Easy, Moderate, Challenging, Very challenging) need to arrange all 4
 - Terrain - priority (Urban, Forest, Mountainous, Coast/ Sea, Cultural landscape) need to arrange all 5
 - Accessibility - Multiple choice (Checkboxes: Movement, Sight, Hearing, Access to quiet room)
 - Sleeping arrangements - Priority (Tent, Indoors, Shelter, Boat) need to arrange all 4
 - Everyone in the patrol has swimming skills - Checkbox
 - Everyone in the patrol has cycling experience - Checkbox
 - Everyone in the patrol has hiking experience – Checkbox
- **Deadline will be second week of February**



Methods of picking as a patrol

- Start Talking!
 - There may be some disagreements
- If there isn't a clear consensus, please make sure you take accessibility into account
- What is a preference vs a requirement
- Try a blind vote
