Meaning: What do I need to bring?


Roverway on Tour

Carry On Luggage;

- 7kg
- Include anything you need for 48 hours e.g. medication

- Sleeping bag (3 Season or more)
- Warm Clothing

- Tents Enough for over 18's and under 18's to be separate.
- Cooking Equipment (Stoves, pans)
- Group First Aid Kit
