

Teach a reef knot using only pictures

Restriction: You may not speak or demonstrate.

Task: Teach another team how to tie a reef knot correctly and explain when it should be used.

Teach tent pitching without speaking

Restriction: No words at all.

Task: Teach a team how to assemble and pitch a small tent or demonstrate the correct pitching process.

Teach map symbols to someone who can't see your demonstration.

Restriction: Your learner can't see what you're showing.

Task: Teach the meaning of five common OS map symbols using verbal descriptions only.

Teach a figure-of-eight knot without demonstrating it.

Restriction: No physical demonstration.

Task: Explain how to tie a figure-of-eight knot using words only.

Teach compass bearings using only one instruction at a time

Restriction: Only one step may be given before the learner acts.

Task: Teach someone how to take and follow a compass bearing.

Teach how to build a simple camp gadget without using your hands.

Restriction: No pointing, gestures or touching equipment.

Task: Direct a team to build a mug tree or simple gadget using rope and poles.

Teach a clove hitch using only drawings.

Restriction: No speaking, writing words or demonstrating.

Task: Draw a sequence that teaches another team how to tie a clove hitch.

Teach an invented game to two learners using different methods.

Restriction: One learner can only listen. One learner can only watch.

Task: Teach both learners how to play a brand-new game and see if they can play together afterwards.
