

What is a World Scout Moot?

The World Scout Moot is an international gathering of over 5,000 Scouts aged 18 to 25 years old from around the world, coming together to share cultures, learn from each other and gain new skills. Every four years, the Moot takes place in a different host country. The next Moot takes place in Portugal in Summer 2025 with the theme 'Engage'.

What happens at a Moot?

Participant experience at a Moot is split into two halves, the first half is a 'Path', exploring the host country in a patrol made up of Scouts from different nationalities. The second half is an on-site Jamboree-style camp along joining up with all the other participants. Our amazing International Service Team are split supporting the Paths or Main Camp

Members of The Scouts aged between 18 and 25 on the first day of the event can attend as **participants** taking part in the event programme. Members of The Scouts aged 26 and over on the first day of the event can attend as **International Service Team** members, working hard to deliver an incredible experience.
