<p><b>1967 - Apollo 7</b></p> <p>The first human Apollo space mission with astronauts named Walter Schirra Jr, Donn Eisele and Walter Cunningham. They orbited Earth 163 times and covered 4.5 million miles.</p>	<p><b>1968 - Apollo 8</b></p> <p>First crew to fly around the moon. The astronauts were William Anders, Frank Borman and James Lovell Jr. They completed 10 orbits of the Earth and covered half a million miles.</p>	<p><b>1969 - Apollo 9</b></p> <p>First test of Lunar module in Earth orbit, carried out by astronauts James McDivitt, David Scott and Russel Schweickart. They completed 151 orbits of the Earth covering 4.2 million miles.</p>
<p><b>1969 - Apollo 10</b></p> <p>Rehearsal for first moon landing.</p>	<p><b>1969 - Apollo 11</b></p> <p>First to land and walk on the Moon. The astronauts were Neil Armstrong, Edwin 'Buzz' Aldrin and Michael Collins. Neil Armstrong became the first man to step on the moon. You may know his famous words 'One small step for man and one giant leap for man kinds.'</p>	<p><b>1969 - Apollo 12</b></p> <p>First precision landing on moon.</p>
<p><b>1970 - Apollo 13</b></p> <p>Intended to land on the Moon, but an oxygen tank explosion forced the crew to return to Earth safely without landing.</p>	<p><b>1971 - Apollo 14</b></p> <p>First moon landing in Lunar highlands. It successfully landed. The astronaut, Alan Shepard, even hit a golf ball on the Moon!</p>	<p><b>1971 - Apollo 15</b></p> <p>The first mission to use a Lunar Rover, allowing astronauts to explore even more on the moon.</p>
<p><b>1972 - Apollo 16</b></p> <p>Explored the Moon's mountainous highlands.</p>	<p><b>1972 - Apollo 17</b></p> <p>The final Moon landing, with the first scientist-astronaut, Harrison Schmitt, on board</p>
