Norwegian Phrase of the Roundup

“Hvor mye koster det?”

Pronounced: vor me-a cost-a de

Meaning: How much does it cost?

Fundraising Step 1: ideas

- Post-event launched last month (we're heading to **Denmark** by overnight ferry, travelling to **Copenhagen** by coach and spending 2/3 days there).
- Travelling to Norway for the event and Denmark afterwards is a big commitment – of time, energy, and of money – hence the need to think about fundraising!
- The first step is to come up with ideas for what you want to do. Get creative – you can use well-worn and tested routes, but why not think about something unique to you?



Fundraising Step 2: plan and agree

- Once you've got your idea, it's time to come up with a plan, and get it agreed.
- Some things to think about are:
 - Numbers
 - Location
 - Timing
 - Publicity

This is not exhaustive!

- You might also need to get your plan agreed by someone in Scouting (County/Area/Region/Nation Commissioner for a badge, for example).



Fundraising Step 3: action it!

- Once you've **got an idea**, come up with a **workable plan** and **got it agreed**, it's time to get out and do it!
- Make sure that safety and safeguarding are front and centre of your thinking.
- **Tell us about what you're doing** – tag us on Instagram, X, or Facebook, email us or use the support form! We may re-post it if it's going places!
- **Badges:** make sure we get some of your badges if you come up with one!



Payments and Grants



- **Participants in a patrol:** your County/Nation should have now been in contact about the first payment.
- **IST members:** the four options for IST fees are now available on the IST Hub:
 - Option 1: Event Only: £900
 - Option 2: Event, Post-Event and Transfers: £1,399
 - Option 3: Flights from UK and Event: £1,499
 - Option 4: All-inclusive: £1,859

Your opportunity to choose your option and make the first payment will be available soon.

- **Grants:** we are working with our Grants team at HQ to provide as many grants as possible. The final details will be available as soon as we can.

Representative Opportunities



- **Youth Forum:** if you applied for the YouShape Team, you should now have been invited to join the Youth Forum!
- **YouShape Team:** we have also developed a sub-group of the Youth Forum that will take a more active role in assisting the CMT. You should have been invited to join the YouShape team if you've been selected.
- **Rover Reps:** we are still working through the many applications we've had for the 2 Rover Rep positions, who will represent the UK in discussions with the Norwegian planners over the next 9 months!
- **IST Envoys:** we are all still working through lots of applications to be an IST Envoy, and will be chatting with you at Roverway on Tour.
