

You were caught running on the train platform. This endangered yourself and others. You made a poor choice!

Move back 3 spaces

You're at a level crossing. You followed the safety announcement guidelines and stopped, looked and listened before crossing the tracks when safe to do so.

You made a good choice!

Move forward 3 spaces

Your friends thought it'd be funny to press the emergency button at the help point on the platform. You did it, even though there's no emergency happening.

You made a poor choice!

Move back 4 spaces

You and your mum noticed someone sitting on a bench on the platform upset and wiping away tears. You go over together, because you'd never approach a stranger alone without a responsible adult. Together, you ask if they're okay, because you know that small talk saves lives. You made a good choice!

Move forward 4 spaces

You were caught crossing the tracks, without using the level crossing provided. You made a poor choice!

Move back 5 spaces

You dropped your phone on the tracks. There's no train coming for 10 minutes. However, instead of getting it yourself, you leave it there and seek help by finding a station attendant. You made a good choice!

Move forward 5 spaces

You're with a group of friends who suggest climbing the fence to hang out on the train tracks. While you know this is wrong, you follow along and join them. You make it over the fence but, just as quickly, the police find you. You made a very poor choice!

Move back 6 spaces

You're with a group of friends who suggest climbing the fence to hang out on the train tracks. You know this is wrong, so you explain all the dangers of this idea, including getting seriously hurt or worse. They listen to you and drop the idea. You and your friends made a good choice!

Move forward 6 spaces

You're taking your dog, Bert, for a walk. As you live in the country, Bert often goes for walks off lead. Bert runs ahead. Bert runs through a level crossing while the barriers are down, meaning a train is approaching. Bert luckily is okay - this time at least. You made a poor choice.
Move back 2 spaces

You're taking your dog, Betty, for a walk. Even though you live in the country, you keep Betty on a lead the whole time. This is because you know there are train tracks around, including a level crossing. You made a good choice!
Move forward 2 spaces

You're approaching a level crossing without barriers. Roll the dice. If you roll an even number, cross safely and take the extra moves of the number you just rolled. If you roll an odd number, stay where you are and wait for the passing train until your next turn.

You find yourself on a crowded platform. Roll the dice. If you roll an even number, you manoeuvre through the crowd safely. You can take the extra moves of the number you rolled. If you roll an odd number, you accidentally trip on someone's bag and sprain your ankle. You must stay where you are until your next turn.

Oops! You were sitting on the edge of the platform with your legs dangling over the tracks. The station attendant comes over to remind you how unsafe this is and how you must stay behind the yellow line. Miss your next turn while you safely step back onto the platform.

Oops! You forgot your headphones, but really want to listen to music. Miss your next turn while you head home to grab headphones for your journey. You can still enjoy music on a train platform. It's important that it's a low volume, so you can still hear important announcements. It's also important to use headphones, so you don't disturb others.
