Some have barriers, lights and alarms, others may simply have a sign reminding you to Stop, Look and Listen to check it's safe to cross the tracks.
Electricity can jump from a wire or cable it's travelling through. How far can electricity jump?	Up to 1 meter	Up to 3 meters	Electricity can't jump	B – Up to 3 metres
Electrical wires and rails are safe, if you don't touch them.	Always	Sometimes	Never	C – Never. Remember to stay away from electrical wires, as electricity can jump (arc) up to 3 metres away from the wire.
