**Part of your shelter has come loose
and needs repairing.**

**A rescue helicopter is nearby but
cannot see your signal.**

**A nearby area has become flooded
and is no longer safe to use.**

**Your signalling device has stopped
working effectively.**

**A team member has lost one of
their gloves.**

One team member has a minor ankle injury and needs support.

A strong gust of wind has blown away some lightweight equipment.

The temperature has dropped significantly.

You hear a rescue team searching in the distance.

Your water supply is running low and needs careful management.

A team member is feeling worried and needs reassurance.

The ground around your shelter is becoming muddy and slippery.

You receive information that rescue may take longer than expected.

Your main signal has become damaged and needs improving.

A weather forecast update predicts a storm arriving soon.

Lost on a Hill Walk

Your group has become separated from the main walking route during a hill walk. The weather is changing, and you need to stay together, build shelter, and help rescuers find you.

Canoe Trip Emergency

During a canoe expedition, strong winds have forced your group to stop on an unfamiliar riverbank. You cannot continue your journey and must create shelter, stay warm, and attract attention.

Survival Camp Challenge

While on a remote camp, a severe storm has damaged your campsite. Your tents are no longer usable, and you need to work together to create shelter and remain safe until help arrives.

Forest Navigation Mistake

During a navigation exercise, your team realises they are lost in a large woodland area. Daylight is fading and the weather is worsening. You must decide how to stay safe, dry, and visible.

Mountain Rescue Situation

Whilst exploring a mountain trail, one member of your party has injured their ankle and cannot continue. Rescue services have been contacted but cannot reach you immediately. You need to create shelter and prepare to spend several hours waiting for help.
