

Wheelchair User

Traveller: Sarah uses a wheelchair.

Journey: Travel from **A to E**.

Needs:

- Smooth, accessible surfaces where possible.
- Avoid steep slopes, narrow gates and stiles.
- Safety is more important than taking the shortest route.

Challenge: Which route would be most accessible and comfortable?

Horse Rider

Traveller: Ben is riding his horse.

Journey: Travel from **A to H**.

Needs:

- Must use routes legally open to horses.
- Wants to avoid busy roads.
- Horse can manage moderate hills.

Challenge: Which rights of way are suitable and which must be avoided?

Family with a Pushchair

Travellers: A family with a toddler in a pushchair.

Journey: Travel from **C to F**.

Needs:

- Easy terrain.
- Wide paths.
- Prefer a slightly longer route if it is easier to navigate.

Challenge: What route would be easiest for the family?

Mountain Biker

Traveller: Alex on a mountain bike.

Journey: Travel from **A to D**.

Needs:

- Wants an interesting ride.
- Must stay on routes where cycling is allowed.
- Happy with rough terrain.

Challenge: Find the best legal route.

Dog Walker

Traveller: Priya walking her energetic dog.

Journey: Travel from **F to B**.

Needs:

- Wants a pleasant walk.
- Prefers quieter routes away from traffic.
- Doesn't mind taking longer.

Challenge: Which route would provide the safest and most enjoyable walk?

Elderly Walker

Traveller: George, aged 78.

Journey: Travel from **D to A**.

Needs:

- Avoid steep hills.
- Needs places to stop and rest.
- Wants the easiest terrain possible.

Challenge: Is the shortest route really the best option?

Farmer on an ATV

Traveller: A farmer checking livestock.

Journey: Travel from **E to G**.

Needs:

- Driving an all-terrain vehicle.
- Must only use routes where motor vehicles are permitted.
- Needs the quickest legal route.

Challenge: Which rights of way can legally be used?

Scout Patrol with a Time Limit

Travellers: A Scout patrol.

Journey: Travel from **B to E**.

Needs:

- Must arrive within an hour.
- Want to avoid hazards.
- Prepared for rough ground.

Challenge: Balance speed and safety.

Nature Photographer

Traveller: A wildlife photographer carrying heavy equipment.

Journey: Travel from **G to C**.

Needs:

- Wants scenic routes.
- Doesn't mind extra distance.
- Needs reasonably stable ground.

Challenge: Which route offers the best experience rather than the shortest journey?
